- January 9, 2012 - registration and abstracts submission. Electronic version of paper abstract (200-300 words in English) should be submitted to the secretariat.
- January 23, 2012 - author notification on abstract acceptance
- March 5, 2012 - draft paper submission. Papers have to be prepared according to the instructions
- April 2, 2012 - authors will be provided with the reviews
- April 23, 2012 - final paper submission
- May 14, 2012 - announcement of the conference program
- May 21, 2012 12 a. m. - submission of the presentation in MS Power Point
- May 24 - 25, 2012 - conference event

Conference rules

Papers submitted to the conference are reviewed by an official, anonymous and young reviewer. Review and questionnaire templates are provided in the conference website.

Official reviewer – a scientist who reviews the paper submitted to the conference and has a discussion with paper author during the session. The official reviewer is chosen from the scientists who do research in the same area as the author of paper being reviewed.

Anonymous reviewer – a scientist who reviews the paper submitted to the conference.

Young reviewer – a person who reviews the paper submitted to the conference. The young reviewer is set randomly from the speakers participating in the conference.

Conference language-English.

Presentation takes 20 minutes, which include 15 minutes for a speaker, 5 minutes for the questions and discussion.



Presentations are divided into the sections. Chairmen of the sessions will be selected from young scientist participating in the conference.

Conference proceedings

Papers submitted to the conference do not need to be original (not published before).

However, only original paper will be included in the conference proceedings (ISSN 1822-7554). Since 2006 conference papers are referred in INSPEC database.

Selected papers of conference proceedings will be considered for publication in the journal Power Engineering (ISSN 0235-7208).

Paper abstracts will be available on the conference website in English.
